This study aims to describe the use of flashcards media in teaching English vocabulary to students with disabilities at SMALB PGRI Purwoasri. The results showed that the use of flashcards as learning media helped students more easily recognize and remember english vocabulary. However, their effectiveness is highly dependent on the teacher's creativity in presenting the material and ability to adapt the learning to each student's condition.
